What is FMD?

A very serious and fast-spreading viral disease in animals with split hooves like cattle, goats, sheep, and pigs.

Signs of FMD?



Painful sores and blisters in the mouth and hooves



Limping and salivation



Abortions in pregnant cattle



Death in calves

How Does FMD Spread?



Sick animals



**Contaminated
Meat/milk**



**Dirty tools,
shoes, vehicles**



Animal feed



**Shared equipment
or sheds**

DO: ✓



**Report any sick animals
IMMEDIATELY**



**Keep healthy and sick
animals apart**



**Clean and disinfect tools,
clothes and shoes**



**Only buy animals from
trusted sources**



**Boil kitchen waste before
feeding pigs**

DO NOT: ✗



**Move animals in or out of
infected areas**



**Mix your animals with those
from unknown sources**



**Feed raw animal products
to pigs**



**Share animal feed, tools, or
vehicles with others**



**Visit outbreak areas unless
necessary**

movements**

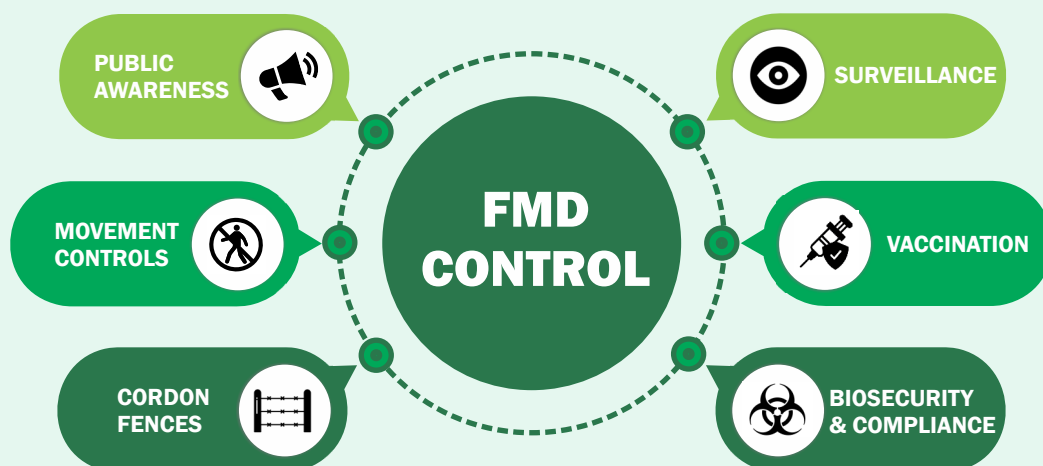


**Follow veterinary
